The board passed a resolution agreeing to the draft that was presented. No final agreement was received for the Supervisor to sign. Clerk Wolfanger received and presented to the board an e-mail from American Tower Corp. informing the Town that the original agreement that was presented by American Tower at the August 04, 2015 meeting and passed by the Town Board that would have given the Town a \$10,000.00 signing bonus and extend the

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length of the cell Tower agreement we have with them, has been changed and reduced to a \$5,000.00 signing bonus due to the height of the cell tower and its ability to add additional cell sites on it. After some discussion the board informed the Clerk to notify American Tower that the contract will be signed with the \$10,000.00 signing bonus but not with the \$5,000.00 signing bonus. If they do not accept that we will continue with the original signed agreement that is in place.
