Supervisor Mahus informed board members that the Town has been reimbursed for the advance funding the Town provided for the Hangar Door Project at Dansville Municipal Airport. He requested a motion to transfer \$198,218.58 to the Town's Building Fund. A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Infantino to transfer \$198,218.58 of the funds reimbursed to the Town from the Hangar Door Project to the Town's Building Fund Account. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Mahus informed the board that the appraisal work for the Mill Creek Property located at 25 Red Jacket St has been completed by KLW Appraisal Group, Inc. He stated that he has information on KLW doing an appraisal for Five Star Bank located at 152 Franklin St.. KLW will provide a restricted appraisal report of the property for \$1,750.00 and if necessary provide a court ready report which will cost an additional \$1,900.00. A motion by Councilperson Infantino and a second by Councilperson Horr to authorize KLW Appraisal Group, Inc to conduct an appraisal of the Five Star property located at 152 Franklin St and to provide a restricted appraisal report at a cost of \$1,750.00 and if necessary to provide a court ready document for this property for an additional \$1,900.00. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED

A motion by Councilperson Infantino and a second by Councilperson Horr to authorize Supervisor Mahus to make a March 15, 2019 interest payment of \$2,418.75 on the Bond for the building project and an April 1, 2019 interest payment of \$14,412.50 and a principal payment of \$75,000.00 for the Water District Bond. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Infantino to pay all bills as audited, General Account Vouchers #25-#52 incl., totaling \$82,519.99, Highway Account Vouchers # 07-#19 incl., totaling \$4,048.25 and Water District Account Voucher #1, totaling \$663.50. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

A motion by Councilperson Infantino and a second by Councilperson Horr to adjourn. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED
